Refunds and Withdrawal Policy

Payments are made to vendors to secure services on behalf of the students in advance of travel and are often non-refundable to CNU. These expenses may include but are not limited to pre-paid meals, pre-paid room or housing reservations, airline deposits or tickets, bus rental fees, etc. Thus, even if you withdraw from the program before the departure, you are still responsible for unrecoverable program costs.

- ⇒ If a student withdraws from program on or before June 30, 2020, the deposit may be refunded to the student.
- ⇒ If a student withdraws from program after June 30, 2020, the deposit will not be refunded.
- ⇒ The final payment is a non-refundable payment.
- ⇒ For CNU study abroad programs, "withdrawal" includes voluntarily withdrawal as well as involuntarily withdrawal due to illness or other circumstances, or if the student is dismissed or suspended from the university for either academic or conduct reasons. If a student is dismissed from the program for academic or conduct reasons after the program begins, or if the student voluntarily withdraws from the program after it has begun, there will be no refund issued to the student for fees that have been charged.
- ⇒ If the program is cancelled due to insufficient student enrollment, then all charges will be refunded.
- ⇒ If the program is cancelled due to an act of war or terrorism, a State Department warning or other circumstances that make the program location unsafe, all fees not already spent on behalf of the student will be refunded.
- ⇒ All withdrawals, as well as any requests for refunds should be made in writing to the Study Abroad Office prior to the dates noted above. It is in the student's best interest to notify the Study Abroad Office immediately upon making a decision to withdraw.
- ⇒ If a student elects or is unable to participate in one or more individual program activities (field trips, group meals, etc.), the cost of these activities cannot be refunded.
