Program Summary:

Students will be involved in the first-hand excavation of the Great Synagogue of Vilna, Lithuania. It was destroyed during the Holocaust and then the remains were buried under a local elementary school. Students will be performing tasks, to include: geoscience surveys, mapping, excavating, cleaning of finds, cataloging, photographing. On a daily basis, participants will study the 500 year famed history of the Jews of Vilnius, known by Napoleon as the "Jerusalem of the North." Students will also visit sites in Lithuania such as the labor camps built by the Nazis, and learn about the Holocaust in Lithuania.
