

Study the Development of Chemistry and Medicine Through the Ages

Czech Republic, Germany, Greece

Chem 110 – AINW (no lab), 21 days

May 7 - 25, 2024 (tentative)

Study abroad in the **Czech Republic** (Prague, Terezin), **Germany** (Munich, Heidelberg, Mainz, and Ludwigshafen), and **Greece** (Athens and the Isle of Kos)



Open to all majors. Three credits. Partially satisfies AINW requirement. There is no prerequisite for this course.

Costs included in \$6125 program fee:

- International airfare and transportation within Europe.
- Lodging, all breakfasts, all course activities, international health insurance.

Costs not included in program fee:

- Tuition: In-state (\$1389) or out-of-state (\$3171) in addition to the program fee.
- Most lunches/dinners, personal spending, passport, any additional baggage fees for extra/overweight bags.

Greece: Visit the Parthenon, the Temple of the God of Medicine, and the Hippocrates Garden Cultural Center; study ancient medicines on the Isle of Kos.

Czech Republic: Visit the Alchemy Museum in Prague to study the roots of modern pharmaceuticals, tour Prague Castle, visit Terezin concentration camp.

Germany: Visit the Gutenberg Museum, tour BASF chemistry exhibition, Carl Bosch Museum, German Museum of Technology, Altstadt University tour, Heidelberg Palace, learn about brewing chemistry.
