FOCUS

This study abroad course introduces students to Roman art and architecture from the death of Julius Caesar (44 BCE) to the rise of Christianity (4th century CE).

HIGHLIGHTS

- Sites (in Rome): Forum Romanum, Colosseum, Pantheon, Circus Maximus, Trajan's Forum, Baths of Caracalla, St. Peter's Basilica, Vatican Museum and many others.
- Sites (outside Rome): Pompeii, Herculaneum, Naples and Paestum
 - In Rome, students will stay at the prestigious Intercollegiate Center for Classical Studies, where they will enjoy first-class accommodations, home-cooked meals and academic resources.
